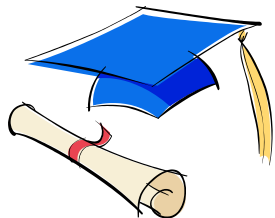

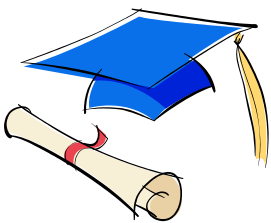
How do we sign up? A registration form is enclosed with this mailing. Complete the form and send it with your check no later than March 9, 2009.

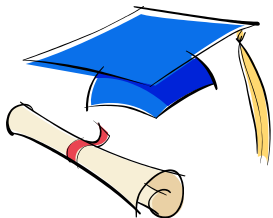
The first \$280 of proceeds from the registration fees will sponsor one Logan County girl’s attendance at Camp GEMS (*Girls in Engineering, Math, and Science*) held at Ohio Northern University during the summer of 2008. This camp is sponsored by Ohio Northern’s Department of Engineering and the Lima area branch of the American Association of University Women. It is designed to encourage seventh and eighth grade girls to consider a career in engineering, math, and/or science. <http://campgems.onu.edu/>

All the remaining funds will be divided between the American Association of University Women’s Educational Foundation and the Logan County Education Foundation!
